*Subject:* UNREALITY.

*Golden Text:* Proverbs 11: 4. Riches profit not in the day of wrath: but righteousness delivereth from death.

*Responsive Reading:*—Proverbs 22: 1, 3-6, 8-12, 16, 28, 29.

1 A good name is rather to be chosen than great riches, and loving favor rather than silver and gold.

29 Seest thou a man diligent in his business? he shall stand before kings; he shall not stand before mean men.
